Power Politics in Indo-Pacific, and India's Challenges

The emergence of a new great power competition and particularly China's rise as an aggressive power suggests that the era when US directed global affairs and enjoyed, highest level of power has gone. The advent of multi polarity due to rise of India, Brazil and South Africa and replacement of Japan by China in Asia-Pacific as a dominating and central force is not only bringing new realities but also changing the power matrix and socio-cultural and civilizational settings. In this new power game while Russia wants to maintain its influence in Europe, China is looking to expand its control and influence in Asia, Africa and Latin America to reduce the US influence as well as also to contain India on the other hand, India is also aspiring for a global role through developing relations with US and other like minded countries, multilateral alliances and economic and defense agreements. In the proposed seminar while discussing the emerging scenario, I will attempt to focus on three things. First the contours of new great power competition, secondly India's challenges in the neighbourhood and Indo-Pacific, thirdly India's strategies and options for countering the challenges and expectations from Israel for defense partnership.
